## Dynamic Dialogue Guidelines

1. Dynamic Doll Dialogues are one of the first educational activities a Convention attendee can participate in. They were created in order to provide more registrants the opportunity to learn and to share information about a particular doll topic.
2. A dialogue consists of a round table of ten (10) participants, including the knowledgeable presenter. Doll Dialogues are scheduled in 50 minute sessions, with a 10 minute rotation phase.
3. The Dialogue presenter must bring 2 to 3 examples of the topic doll being highlighted.
4. To obtain priority registration through Dynamic Doll Dialogues, you must lead at least four (4) dialogues within the two-day period.
5. Dynamic Doll Dialogues applications are **accepted until May 5, 2012 BUT** for your doll topic to be listed as a “teaser” in the Convention event registration booklet: decide your topic (you can present more than one), fill out the Dynamic Doll Dialogue Application and return by **December 30, 2011**
6. You will receive notification via e-mail or mail confirming receipt of your doll dialogues application and placement on the schedule.

### Upon Arrival at the Dialogues:

1. Arrive 15 minutes prior to your schedule presentation to give you time to set up your table before another session starts.
2. At the registration table sign-in and get your dialogue topic sign and pins; then pick out a table and put your topic sign in the card holder on the table and set up your display.
3. Greet your participants as they join you, introduce yourself and your topic
4. Give one “participation button” to each person at your table. Tell them that they get one button per day. They are to wear the button so that other presenters can see they already have one.
5. Once your guests are seated (9) and you have begun, try not to let others sit in. Tell them they can sit in your next session.
6. When you have completed your dialogue commitment(s), please bring your remaining pins and table topic sign to the sign-in table.
