EBAY!!

Yes, UFDC is now set up for the on-line Charity eBay auctions to help raise funds for UFDC!! This is our first fundraising project and hopefully many more!! The success of this project will depend on in-kind donations from individuals and clubs. Please urge all members of your doll club and doll club too to donate monthly, quarterly, or yearly (the more the merrier!!) to help raise funds for UFDC. Remember to set up UFDC up in your "Saved Seller" list to check often on what UFDC is doing on eBay to support UFDC!! You might just find that "on my dolly list" item(s) you've been searching for!!

Go on-line at UFDC.org for the form necessary to send items to UFDC. Once at the UFDC website, click on "Home" then scroll down and click on "UFDC - eBay" to print out the necessary form for submitting in-kind donations.

Remember, these are donations that are fully tax-deductible on their yearly federal tax form as a charitable donation individually or the doll club, which is required by IRS codes to donate funds to a charitable organization yearly to keep up UFDC's 501(c)(3) corporation status as a charitable organization. A receipt for the IRS information will be mailed to you from UFDC upon the completion of the eBay auction.

The regions will be divided into four fairly equal groups with one group assigned to each quarter of the coming year. Please be prepared to urge all the clubs in your region to donate during your quarter. Region 12 will be in the fourth quarter. Also, please encourage individuals to donate at any time. Of course, all members and any interested others need to be prepared to buy from the UFDC. The form for making donations to the UFDC on-line auctions is up on the website for any and all to use. If you wish to support UFDC by donating items that can be taken as a tax write-off or bidding on items you wish to purchase for your own collection, please go to www.ufdc.org for a form.

Thanks to donations from clubs and MAL's in Regions 2S, 3, 11, 15, 16, and others, the UFDC on eBay is up and running. The probationary status of all new eBay accounts, limiting the listings to ten items per month, has now been lifted. You can expect to see new items listed weekly. Some of you who have been waiting to see your items listed can now expect to see them coming up.

Clubs and MAL's from Regions 6, 9 10, 13 are being asked to donate during the months of January, February, and March. This is a fun way to support the UFDC and possibly make a good buy.

Did You Know ...

That when you do not book a reservation at the hotel the UFDC Doll Convention is being held, and that you are attending, it costs UFDC. They sign a contractual agreement with the hotel to book so many rooms and at a certain dollar amount for the annual doll convention. When the rooms are not all booked the balance remaining is paid by UFDC. At the 2011 UFDC Annual Doll Convention held in Anaheim, California, it cost \$50,000.00 to the treasury of the UFDC for non-booked rooms. And, as a charitable organization, this hits the budget really hard.

A doll show that was in the area so nicely placed in their advertisements, at the bottom part of their advertisements, to come stay at their hotel because it was cheaper. Now, was that fair to UFDC? We all love this doll show, which goes on before and during part of the UFDC Doll Convention and many UFDC members, including myself, attend and find wonderful dolls, toys, and accessories.

So, when you are booking hotel rooms for your next UFDC Doll Convention, consider the end results to UFDC. Please remember, we are a charitable organization and can only make money from donations!

To lower your costs at the doll convention, try a roommate to share costs, and make sure all those sharing a room are listed on the hotel's reservation. Or, those who live within a quick drive to the event, how about a monetary donation to UFDC to go toward convention rooms that is fully tax-deductible on their yearly federal tax form as a charitable donation! There are also other areas to help reduce costs of the convention to UFDC by either individuals or doll clubs that can donate, just contact UFDC for a list.
