ANTIQUUE

COSTUMED BY EXHIBITOR – ANTIQUUE

Each article of clothing must be made by the exhibitor and must be removable. All fabrics and trim used should be of the specified period or, if modern, of the correct fiber content, pattern, scale and color representing the period pre 1920. Shoes must be made by the exhibitor or molded on the doll. If used, accessories created by the exhibitor should be securely attached to the doll or to the costume.

Only the costume with (if any) accessories will be judged. The costume will be judged on style, workmanship, fabric selection, historic accuracy and fit on the doll.

The doll may be of any age and any material but must represent the time period specified by the category. Artist dolls and reproduction dolls are included and must represent the period specified.

Theme

What is more appropriate while in New Orleans than to attend a Mardi Gras ball! Choose a doll representing a period no later than 1920. The doll may be male or female. Dress the doll as if he or she is attending a gala Mardi Gras ball. All dolls must have a mask created by the exhibitor. The dolls may wear the mask or it may be carried or attached.

Please include a 3x5 card stating what period of time your doll represents.

MODERN

COSTUMED BY EXHIBITOR - MODERN

Exhibitor must make all clothing and accessories except for the shoes. Costumes will be judged on creativity, design, craftsmanship, and suitability to the doll design. Doll will not be judged.

- A. Female doll costumed to represent Mardi Gras participant, 21” or under. Doll may be any maker or manufacturer. Excludes cloth.
- B. Female doll costumed to represent “Gone With the Wind” character, 21” or under: Scarlett, Melanie, etc.
- C. Male doll costumed to represent “Gone With the Wind” character, 21” or under: Rhett, Ashley, etc.
- D. Black female doll costumed to represent “Gone With the Wind” character, 21” or under: Mammy, Prissy etc.

CREATED BY EXHIBITOR – MODERN

Exhibitor must make entire doll including all clothing and accessories. Shoes may be commercially manufactured. Doll will be judged on design, craftsmanship, originality, and creativity.

- A. Outrageously designed CLOTH character doll, using elements of fabric prints, trim, design, and color to convey the spirit of New Orleans, 20" or under. Doll must be an original design.
- B. Child doll, all felt, 18" or under.
- C. Female character to represent and depict life in the French Quarter.
- D. Male character inspired by the song "When the Saints Come Marching In".

PAPER DOLL CREATED BY EXHIBITOR – MODERN

Please bring some type of easel to fit in a space 18" x 24" or artwork will be displayed flat on the table.

- A. Paper Doll in Mardi Gras attire.
- B. Paper Doll depicting a French historical figure.

TEDDY BEAR CREATED BY EXHIBITOR - MODERN

Exhibitor must make the entire bear and all clothing. Bear will be judged on design, craftsmanship, and creativity.

- A. Teddy Bear Pair costumed in Mardi Gras attire, 8"-16".
- B. Teddy Bear costumed as a Jazz Musician, 16" or under.
